

# **Guinea Pig Supply List**

## Required items:

- -Minimum Cage Requirement: Midwest or 2 x 4 (24" X 48") 1 to 2 piggies
- -Bedding: Fleece liners, Care Fresh, Kiln Dried Pine bedding, or Aspen Wood Bedding
- -Food: Unlimited timothy hay, Quality food pellets, Fresh vegetables daily, Fresh fruit occasionally, and Unlimited Water bottle
- -Hideys (at least 2 for 2 piggies)
- -Hay tray
- -Pellet bowl
- -Piggie-safe cleaning products

### Recommended items:

- -Fleece cuddle items
- -Wooden Chew Toys
- -Equine pellets for bottom of hay tray (helps reduce odors)
- -Cage bumpers (keeps hay off the ground)
- -Bonding Burrito/Carry bag (to carry piggie safely without getting peed on)

#### **Medical Supplies:**

#### Essential:

- -Miconazole Shampoo
- -Critical Care
- -Kitchen scale for weighing the piggies
- -Small Nail clippers

#### Recommended:

- -Baby Gas Drops
- -Liquid Vitamin C
- -Curved tip syringes for feeding Critical Care, Vitamin C, etc.
- -Bene-Bac Probiotic
- -Epsom salts (plain unscented)
- -Small flashlight
- -Stethoscope
- -Pedialyte
- -Heating Pad

#### Things to avoid:

- -Aerosol sprays anywhere near the piggies
- -Any foods high in calcium
- -Scented candles
- -Harnesses or Balls to run in DANGEROUS
- -Honey sticks or Yogurt Drops
